FUND OBJECTIVE & PRINCIPAL INVESTMENT STRATEGIES

The ICON Opportunities Fund seeks long-term capital appreciation. It uses a quantitative methodology to identify securities ICON believes are underpriced relative to value. It normally invests at least 80% of its net assets, plus any borrowings for investment purposes, in companies with a market capitalization that is within or below the range of companies in the S&P SmallCap 600 index. This strategy may not be changed unless Fund shareholders are given at least 60 days' prior notice.

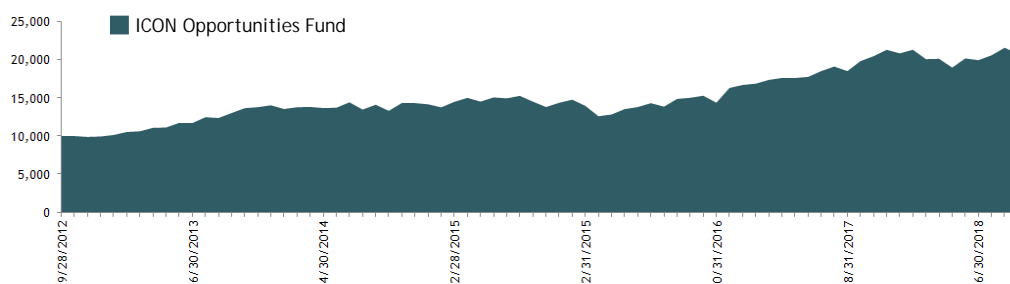

Gross Expenses are all customary expenses incurred by a Fund, excluding, where applicable, waivers, reimbursements, and contractually agreed-to limits of the total expenses by the Fund's adviser. Net Expenses are all customary expenses incurred by a Fund, including, where applicable, waivers, reimbursements, and contractually agreed-to limits of the total expenses by the Fund adviser.
