We are making a couple of changes in the Strategy Based Portfolios. The Core portion includes four domestic strategies based on strategy returns since 1980. The manager pursuing the Profitability strategy is being replaced because, as stated in its prospectus, it has changed its primary strategy. This is unusual and dictates replacing it with a manager pursuing the Profitability strategy.

In the Explore portion of the portfolios an international Risk manager is being replaced by a domestic Future Growth manager. For the Explore portion, our system tracks strategy performance to indicate which strategies we believe will outperform. In this case, we believe that the Future Growth strategy will be a leader replacing the Risk strategy. As always, we select highly ranked managers in each strategy.
