Strategy Based Investing Portfolios

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There has been a trade in the tactical, or "explore", portion of the Strategy Based Investing portfolios. Funds for the tactical portion are generally selected based on which strategy has been performing the best over the last twelve months and the market barometer's preference for domestic or international exposure. An international Profitability manager has replaced international Risk. According to the SBI system, managers pursuing a Profitability strategy select stocks based on profitability statistics such as profit margins, return on assets, and return on equity. The primary objective of a Risk manager is to reduce risk. As the market barometer is currently fairly neutral regarding domestic versus international preference, the tactical portion remains half domestic and half international.
